ELECTION OF VICE PRESIDENTS OF THE DIOCESAN CONFERENCE FOR THE TRIENNIAL PERIOD 2022 - 2025

1. **Purpose of report**

To elect Vice Presidents of the Diocesan Conference for the next triennium period.

2. **Background**

The procedure for electing Vice Presidents of the Diocesan Conference is detailed in Article 3 of The Constitution of the Diocese of St Asaph. The relevant section is reproduced below:

ARTICLE 3: OFFICERS OF THE CONFERENCE

14. The Standing Committee may appoint up to two clerical and two lay members from its membership to act as Vice-Presidents of the Conference for that triennium and who shall share with the President in chairing meetings of the Diocesan Conference and its Standing Committee as invited by him/her.

Membership of the Standing Committee is defined in Article 6 of The Constitution of the Diocese of St Asaph. The relevant section is reproduced below:

ARTICLE 6: NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS
