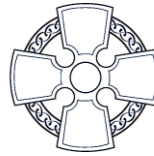

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

To support the wellbeing and long-term sustainability of those serving as ordained clergy across the Province, the Church in Wales and St Luke's for Clergy Wellbeing are delighted to offer funded, professional pastoral supervision providing a confidential and theologically-grounded space to reflect, realign, and remain rooted in healthy patterns of ministry.

Over an 18-month period, participants receive dedicated time to explore their vocation, their context, and the pressures they hold, with the aim of strengthening resilience, nurturing self-awareness and enabling flourishing in their ongoing service.

This scheme is open to all ordained clergy in the Church in Wales. Priority may be given to those in their first post of responsibility, though clergy at every stage of ministry are warmly encouraged to express interest. At least 36 places will be available, drawn from across all dioceses of the Church in Wales.
