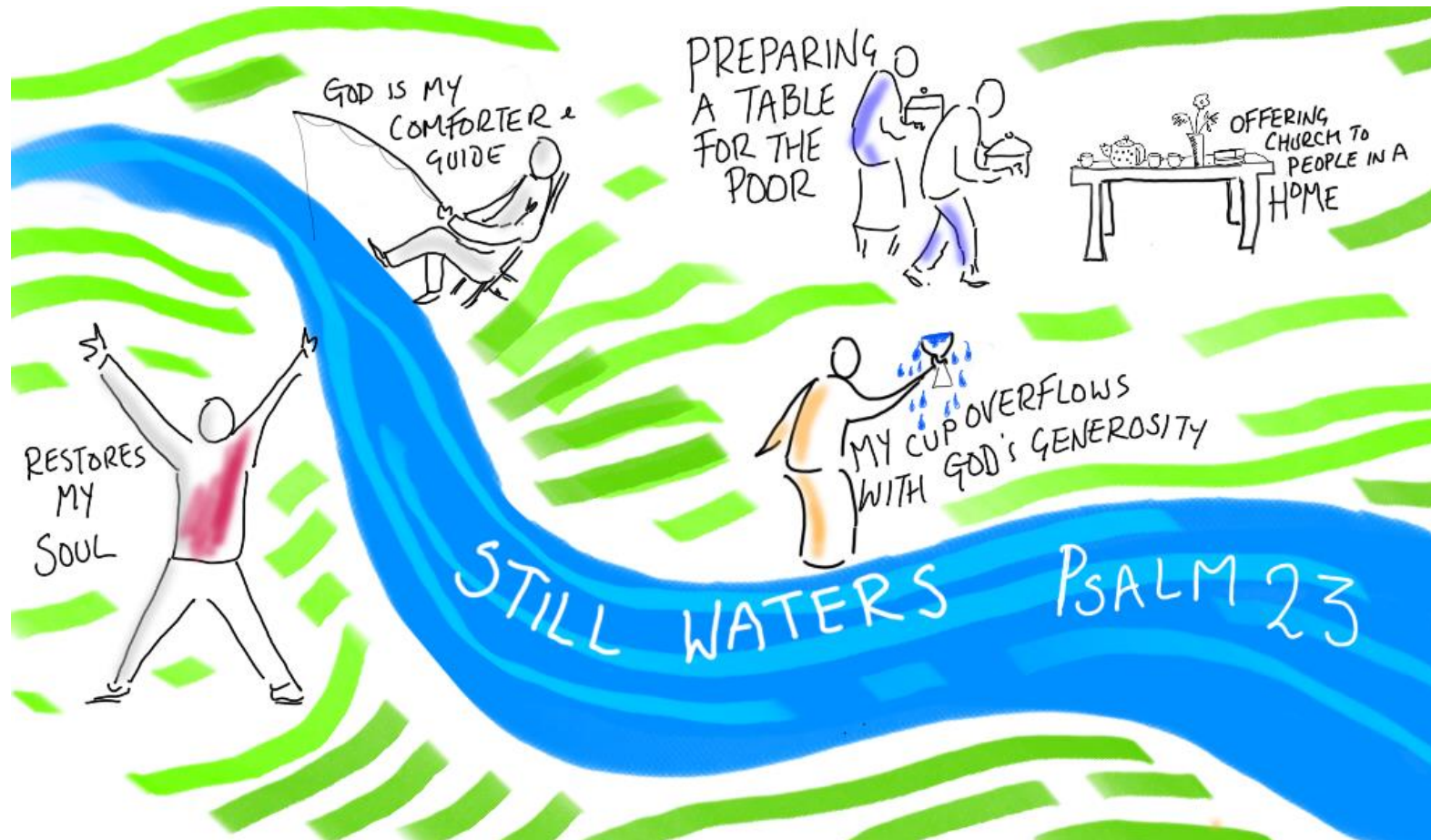

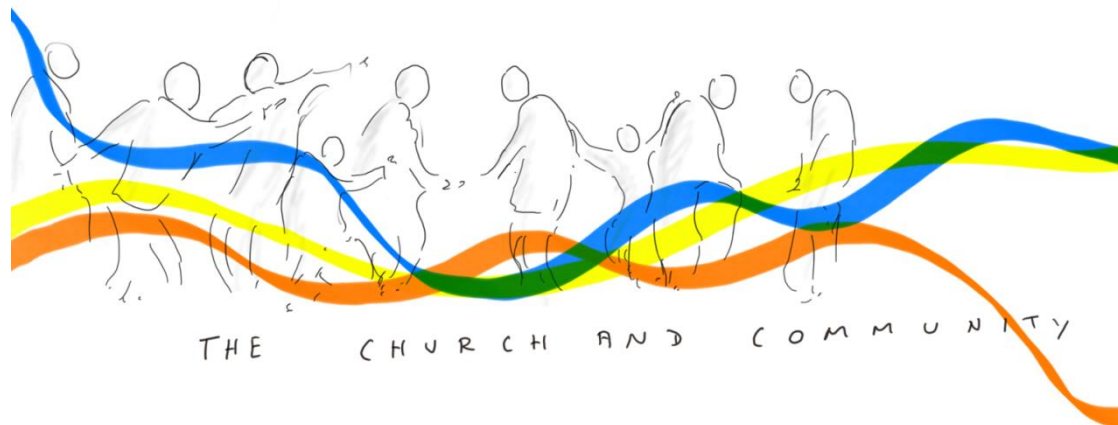

3. What role can the church play in responding to these situations in a way that builds community?



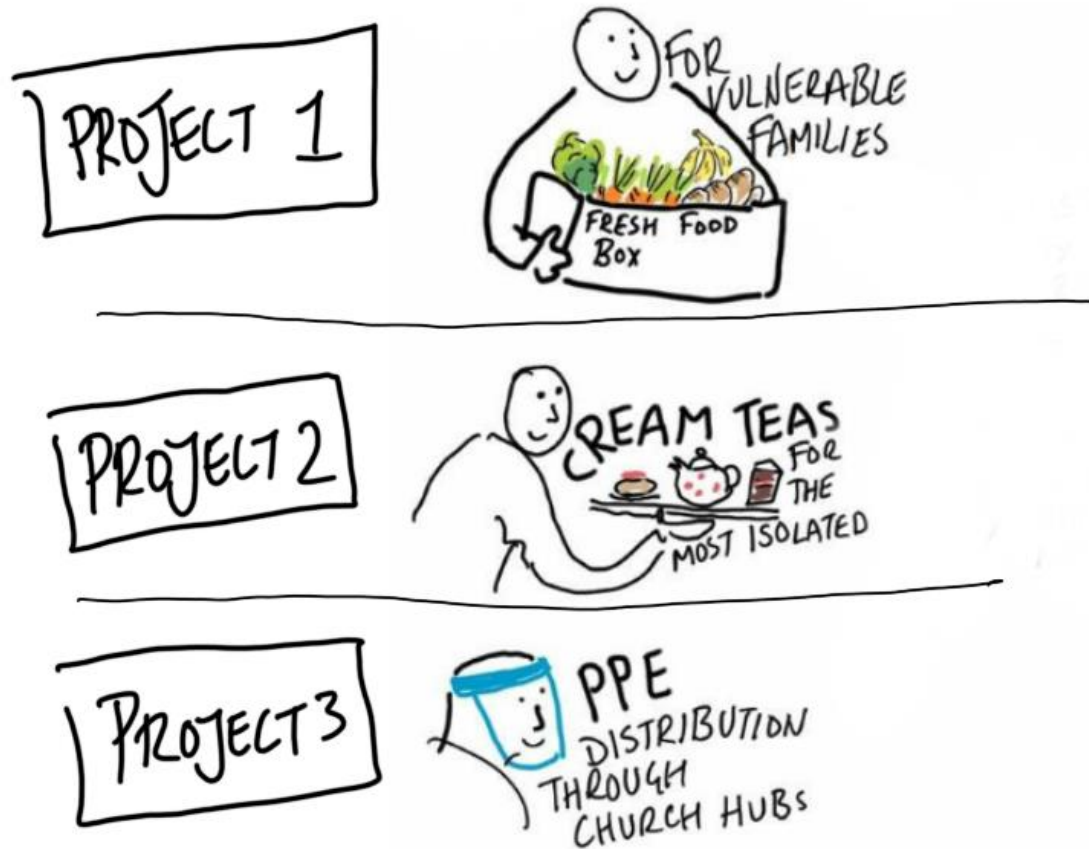

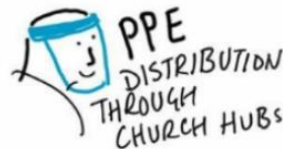

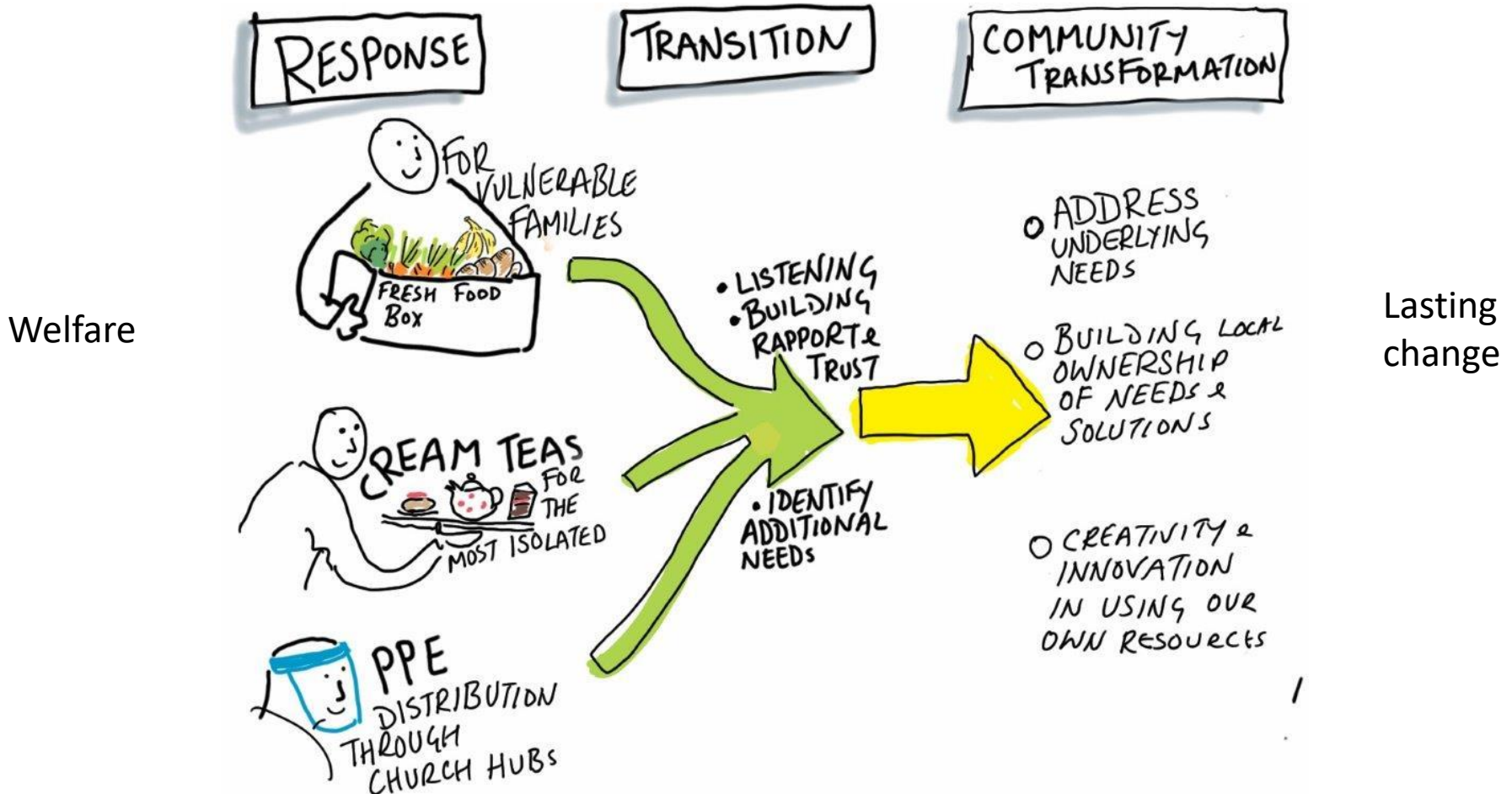
