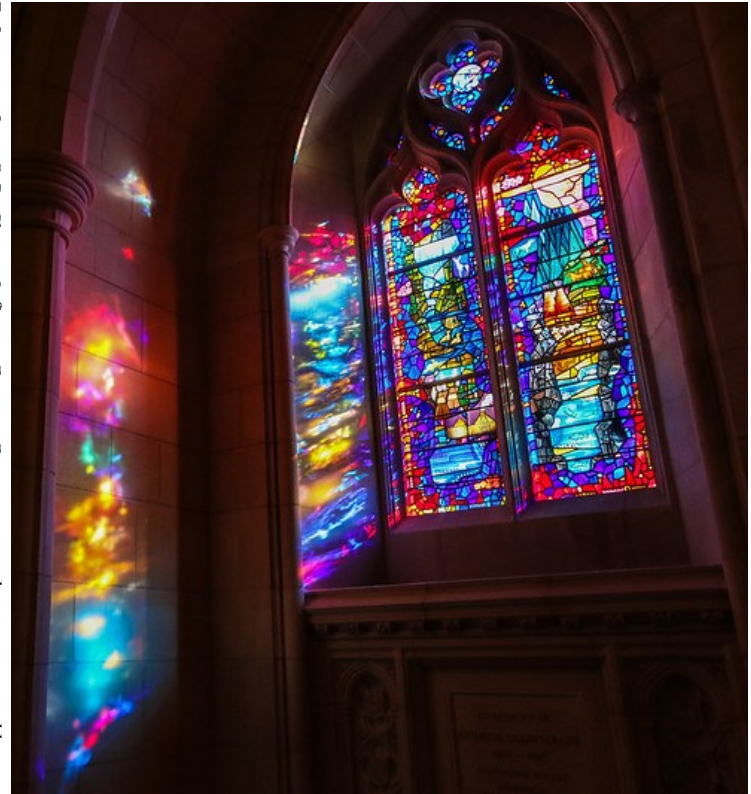

Amen.

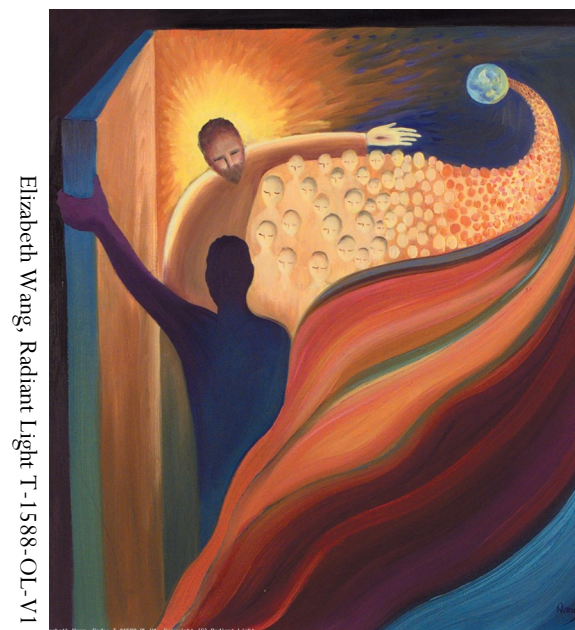

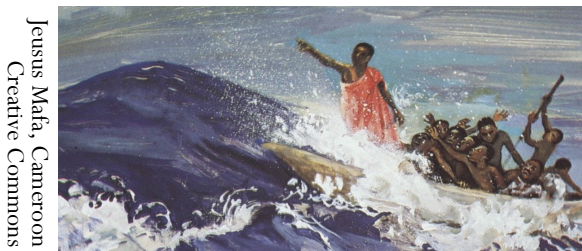
Blessing in the Storm

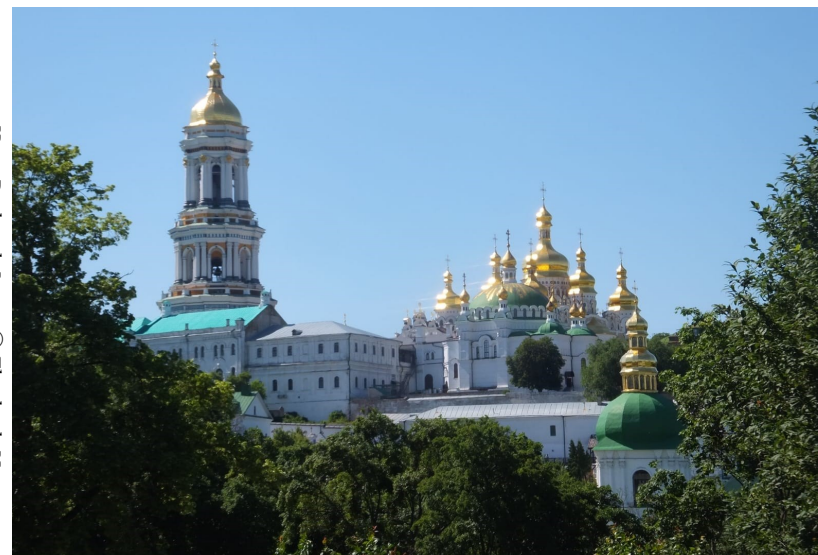

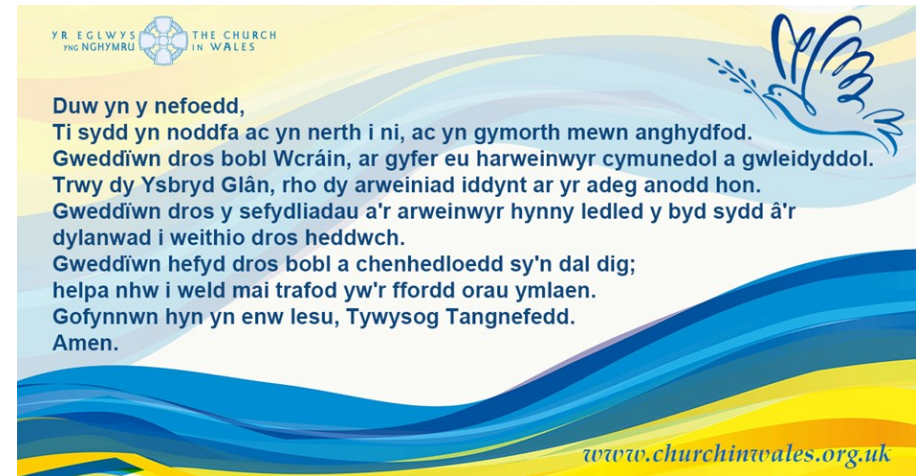

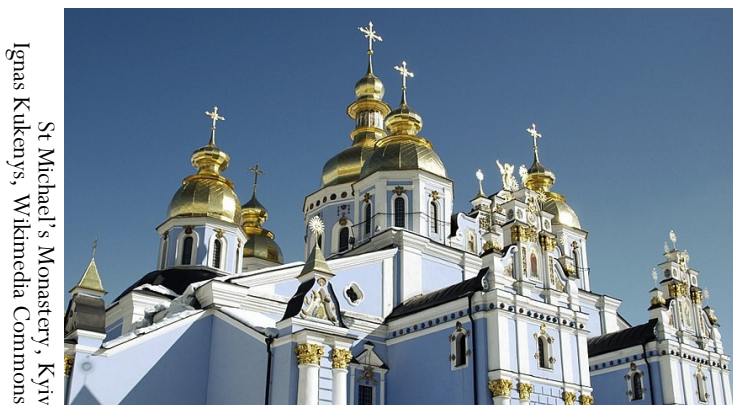
